

At the Parker Fieldhouse, the turf field, inline rink, gym, batting cages, climbing wall and activity rooms are all available for rent. The Parker Recreation Center and H2O'Brien Pool also offer rental opportunities and party packages. For more information on Recreation rental rates, please call 303.841.4500.

The Town also has several parks that may be rented for private picnics and other activities. To hold an event at a Town park, a special event permit must be submitted online through the Town's website at [www.parkeronline.org/trakit](http://www.parkeronline.org/trakit).

### **Street Banners**

Outside organizations may request the use of Town lightpoles to hang street banners for the promotion of Parker events. Applicants provide their own banners and certain restrictions apply. 

### ***Town Publications and Website***

The Town regularly sends out publications to its residents and updates the Town website at [www.parkeronline.org](http://www.parkeronline.org). These communications reach thousands of Parker residents and the general public.

### ***Monthly Newsletter - Talk of the Town***

The Communications Department publishes a monthly newsletter that is sent to more than 20,000 households in incorporated Parker. Although the Town is unable to accommodate requests to publish articles about private and non-profit events in the newsletter, it does contain a community calendar of events that you may submit your information to be published in. The deadline for submissions is the 15th of the month preceding the issue you would like your event published. The newsletter does not take advertisements.

Additionally, the Talk of the Town has a section called “Did You Know” on the back of each issue. Businesses and individuals can submit two to three sentences about their events or happenings and the information will be printed, space allowing. Please note, if you

submit to this section, it is not guaranteed that your information will be printed.
