About the Plan

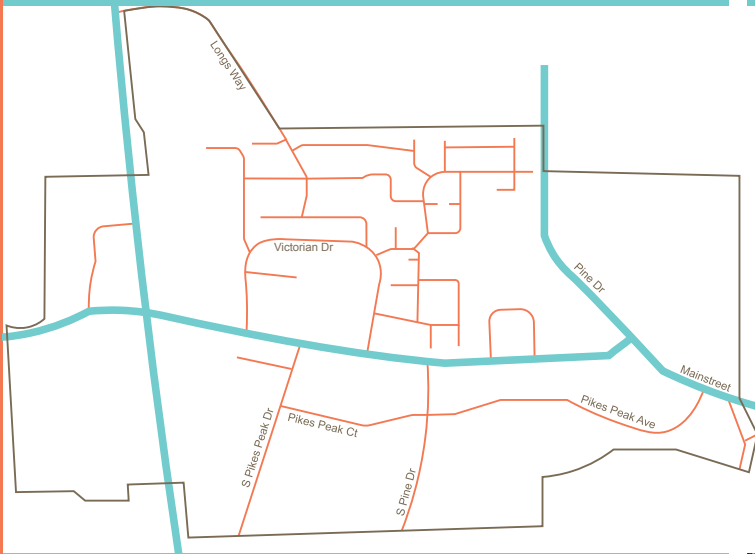


With public and private investment on the rise in Downtown Parker, the Town has identified the need to plan to meet the parking and mobility needs of everyone who enjoys the Town’s vibrant urban core.

In June 2016, the Town contracted with Kimley-Horn and Associates to develop a strategic parking plan for Downtown Parker.

The purpose of the study is to identify current and future parking and access needs in a way that prepares the community for future growth while also balancing the desire to maintain Parker’s local, hometown feel.
