

## **EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 12-2020**

### **ISSUED BY THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR**

On March 13, 2020, the Town Administrator for the Town of Parker did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker (the “Emergency Declaration Order”). The Emergency Declaration Order is to be in effect until March 20, 2020, and consent has been obtained by the Parker Town Council to extend the Emergency Declaration Order to such time as the Town Administrator shall determine, in her discretion.

Pursuant to Section 15.14 of the Parker Town Charter, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property. Such authority may include but not be limited to establishing regulations governing conduct and activities related to the cause of the emergency.

The purpose of this Emergency Order 12-2020 is to extend the expiration of approvals for site plans, use by special review, sketch plans, preliminary plans, final plats, minor development plats – single-family and minor development plats – nonresidential and multiple – family that are currently in effect and in good standing as of the date of this Order. This Emergency Order shall:

1. Extend the expiration of approval for a site plan and use by special review contained in Section 13.01.140(b) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the expiration date provided by this Subsection.
2. Extend the expiration of approval for a sketch plan contained in Section 13.07.060(1) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the one (1) year expiration date provided by this Subsection.
3. Extend the expiration of approval for a preliminary plan contained in Section 13.07.070(i)(2) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the one (1) year expiration date provided by this Subsection.
4. Extend the expiration of approval for a final plat contained in Section 13.07.080(h)(2) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the ninety (90) day expiration date provided by 13.07.080(h)(1).
5. Extend the expiration of approval for a minor development – single-family contained in Section 13.07.090(j)(2) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the ninety (90) day expiration date provided by 13.07.090(j)(1).
6. Extend the expiration of approval for a minor development – nonresidential and multiple-family contained in Section 13.07.100(j)(2) of the Parker Municipal Code for four (4) additional months beyond the ninety (90) day expiration date provided by 13.07.100(j)(1).

This Emergency Order No. 12-2020 shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect through the duration of the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency, or until it is terminated or amended by the Town Administrator.
