

SECOND AMENDED EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 15-2020

ISSUED BY THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

On March 13, 2020, the Town Administrator for the Town of Parker did issue an Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Parker (the "Emergency Declaration Order"). The Emergency Declaration Order is to be in effect until March 20, 2020, and consent has been obtained by the Parker Town Council to extend the Emergency Declaration Order to such time as the Town Administrator shall determine, in her discretion.

Pursuant to Section 15.14 of the Parker Town Charter, the Town Administrator shall assume the authority to execute any action necessary for the protection of life and property. Such authority may include but not be limited to establishing regulations governing conduct and activities related to the cause of the emergency.

The purpose of this Emergency Order No. 15-2020 is to implement requirements for the use of non-medical face coverings that cover the nose and mouth and social distancing by members of the public that enter and remain within Town-owned buildings, to protect public health and safety.

This Emergency Order shall provide as follows:

(1) To reduce the risk of disease transmission, members of the public that enter and remain within Town-owned buildings shall at all times wear a non-medical face covering that covers the nose and mouth.

(2) To reduce the risk of disease transmission, members of the public that enter and remain within Town-owned buildings shall at all times maintain at least a six-foot distance from other individuals.


(3) Failure to comply with this Order will result in removal from Town-owned buildings.

~~(4) The foregoing requirement concerning face coverings in section (1) shall not apply to patrons, instructors and program participants at the Recreation Center, Fieldhouse, The Schoolhouse and PACE Center during activities requiring moderate to heavy physical exertion; provided such patrons, instructors, and program participants are otherwise practicing physical distancing. In accordance with guidance from the CDPHE, guests of special events (weddings and other small events) at the PACE Center, The Schoolhouse and Ruth Memorial Chapel shall not be required to wear face coverings, as long as such gatherings are of 10 or fewer people and physical distancing is observed; provided, however, event staff shall be required to wear face coverings as required by CDPHE and/or OSHA.~~

This Emergency Order No. 15-2020 shall be effective immediately and shall remain in effect through the duration of the Order Declaring a Local Disaster Emergency, or until it is terminated or amended by the Town Administrator.

THIS EMERGENCY ORDER IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS: SECTION 4 OF THIS EMERGENCY ORDER IS HEREBY TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED FOR AS LONG

AS EXECUTIVE ORDER D 2020 138, ORDERING INDIVIDUALS IN COLORADO TO WEAR NON-MEDICAL FACE COVERINGS IN ANY PUBLIC INDOOR SPACE, SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT.
